ABBREVIATIONS:-EiC = Evidence in Chief; XX = Cross examination by opposing participants in the Inquiry; IQ = Inspector's Questions; RX = Re-examination by the advocate for the witness's own side. NOTES:

1. There will usually be mid morning and mid afternoon breaks of about 10 minutes each and a lunch adjournment of up to an hour commencing at about 1pm or at a convenient point. The Inquiry will usually adjourn at about 5pm but earlier on Fridays in order to allow for long journeys.
2. The times are estimated and the timetable is subject to change before and during the inquiry.
3. If evidence on a particular topic is completed ahead of the forecast time, every effort is to be made to save Inquiry time by bringing forward evidence on other subjects.
4. If the parties consider that inadequate time has been allowed in the timetable for a particular witness or topic, they should suggest how time can be saved elsewhere whilst still completing the Inquiry within the agreed number of days.
5. Other persons wishing to take part in a topic session will be accommodated if time allows.
6. It may be possible to accommodate members of the public speaking on any topic at other times.
7. The Inspector should not be approached during the adjournments. At the start of each morning and afternoon sessions he will provide opportunities for questions or requests about Inquiry procedure or to introduce necessary documents.
