2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX on any day after the date of this notice, during normal office hours but no later than **4pm on Friday 24 July 2026**.
3. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 20 August 2026**.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by **midnight on Tuesday 4 August 2026**. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote
5. New postal vote applications (including proxies applying to vote by post), changes or cancellations to existing postal, postal proxy or proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by **5pm on Wednesday 5th August 2026**.
6. New applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy) at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by **5pm on Wednesday 12 August 2026**.
7. Applications for Voter Authority Certificates must be made by **5pm on Wednesday 12 August 2026**.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by **5pm on Thursday 20 August 2026**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after **5pm on Wednesday 12 August 2026**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after **5pm on Wednesday 12 August 2026**.
