The Minister of Housing and Local Government in pursuance of the powers reserved to him by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1940, hereby approves the above Direction, subject to the following modification:-

The following shall be substituted for the Schedule to the Order:-

Schedule

- (1) The use for any purpose on not more than twenty-eight days in total in any calendar year, and the erection or placing of movable structures on the land for the purpose of that use, being development comprised within paragraph 2 of Class IV of the said Order; and
- (2) The use for the purposes of recreation or instruction by members of an organisation which holds a certificate of exemption granted by the Minister of Health under Section 269 of the Public Health Act 1936, and the erection or placing of tents or caravans on the land for the purposes of that use, being development comprised within Class V of the said Order.
