

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCILTOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1963DIRECTION RESTRICTING PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS the Council of the County of Norfolk being the local planning authority for the Rural District of Docking are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on the pieces of land situate in the parishes of Heacham and Snettisham in the Rural District of Docking in the County of Norfolk and coloured orange on the plan annexed hereto, unless permission therefor is granted on an application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963.

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article IV of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963, hereby direct that the permission granted by Article III of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The temporary use of land for the purposes of public amusement or entertainment or for camping or the sale of goods, including beach requisites, foodstuffs and refreshments; and the erection or placing of movable structures, including motor vehicles, caravans or trailers on the land for the purposes of that use.

Being development comprised within paragraph 2 of Class IV of Part I referred to in the First Schedule to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Class.

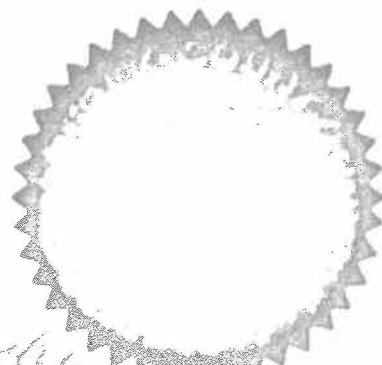
