The grounds are open 7 days a week, as well as Bank Holidays and Christmas, meaning you can visit at a time special to you.

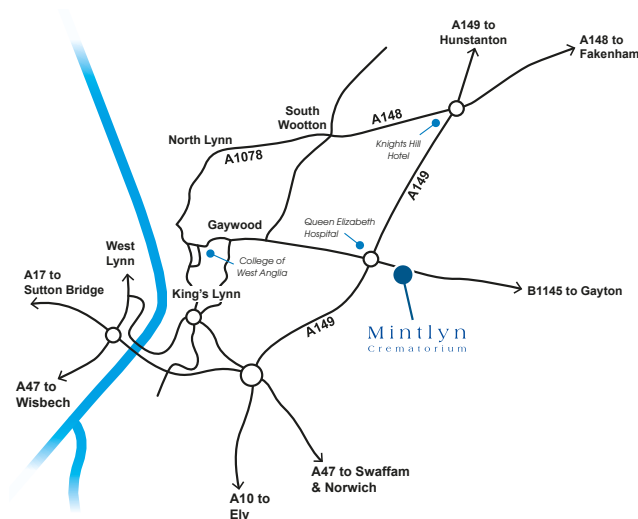
The grounds at Mintlyn are a haven for wildlife, and whilst we welcome you paying respects to your loved ones, we kindly request that flowers are removed from plastic wrapping, and that items such as wind chimes, balloons and solar lights are not placed at the memorial.

Poppy wreaths and Christmas wreaths can be placed at memorials in the run up to these events. Our grounds teams will remove them – notices confirming removal dates will be placed within the grounds for your information.

We politely request that dogs are not brought into the grounds, there is a designated dog walking area adjacent to the main car park that can be used.
