

The chapel and grounds are open daily Monday to Friday/Weekends and Bank Holidays:

- 1 October to 31 March 8:30am – 4:45pm/10:00am-4:30pm
- 1 April to 30 September 8:30am-6:30pm/10:00am–6:00pm
- The gates are opened on Christmas Day but the office is not staffed.

The Crematorium Public Enquiry Office is open Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm. There is security on site at weekends and on bank holidays if needed.

Poppies can be placed in the grounds in November, poppies will be removed the 3rd Sunday after Remembrance Sunday.

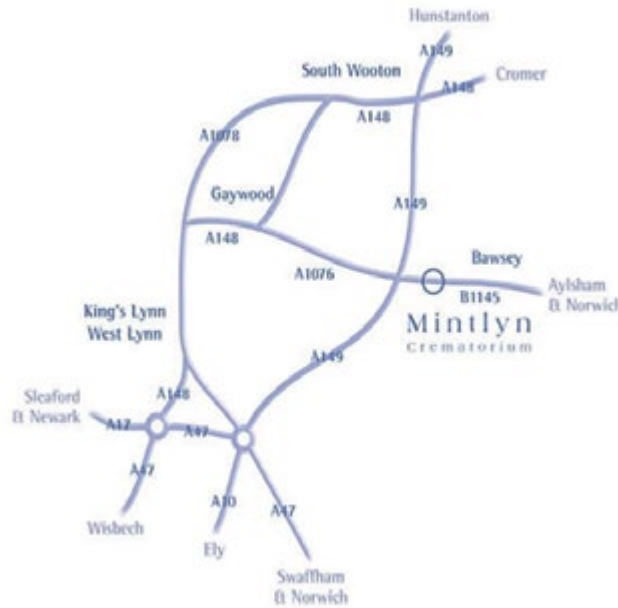
Holly wreaths may be placed with any memorial during December. Holly wreaths will be removed the 1st Sunday after the 1st January.

To keep our gardens tidy we must ask you not to put any tribute, such as flowers, plants, cards, ornaments or toys in the Gardens of Remembrance. Our policy is that they will be removed. Mintlyn requests that you put such tributes in the Book of Remembrance room. Perishable items removed from the grounds will be discarded. Non perishable items will be kept for 6 months before being discarded.

Members of the public are reminded that unauthorised scattering of cremated remains (ashes) is against the law in these grounds, where statutory records need to be complete and various cremation and burial laws observed. Any unauthorised remains scattered could be subject to disturbance.

Dogs are not allowed in the grounds, other than in the designated dog walking area shown on the map. When using the dog walking area dogs must be kept on leads and all fouling removed.
