Update No. 8

Traffic Management

The Spencer Road / Hamburg Way road closure is currently in operation, this will be in place until the 22nd August. During this time there will be three-way traffic lights at the Edward Benefer Way / Bergen Way junction during the morning and evening peak hours.

The Internal Drainage Board are progressing with their rising main, this requires the Sandringham Railway Path to be diverted onto Reid Way and Front Way.

Progress

The northern car park for Lynnsport is being surfaced, this car park needs to become operational to enable the southern car park to be improved.

The old corrugated culvert underneath Spencer Road is being removed and will be replaced with a 1.8m internal diameter concrete pipe.

Part of the re-aligned Hamburg Way has been surfaced and a new maintenance bay / loading bay and verge are being created.

The re-alignment of Hamburg Way is progressing, the new kerblines have been cut and the excavator is removing the existing carriageway which will become the widened verge.
