

Inspector's Question 4 to the Council

Transport Implications of Development

Firstly reference is made in paragraph 15 of the Statement from WYG (REP02-09 on behalf of the Castle Rising Estate) to reported comments made by the Highways Agency regarding the provision of a dual-carriageway.

Could the Council confirm whether or not any concerns regarding the transport implications of the proposed development in the Borough have been expressed by the Highways Agency (now Highways England) and if so could they be made available.

Secondly Norfolk County Council, as Highway Authority (HA), has made comments regarding the suitability of proposed allocations at Dersingham, East Rudham, Southery, Ten Mile Bank, Terrington St Clement and Walpole St Peter. The HA has not requested to attend the hearing sessions. As a starting point, therefore, I would welcome the Council's response to these matters raised by the HA and suggest that there may be some benefit in further dialogue between the two parties.

A response before the start of the hearing sessions would be helpful.
