Application under the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010 (as amended) Ref: SWIP001

The company known as Freedom Resource Conversion Ltd has applied to the Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk to operate a Small Waste Incineration Plant under Section 13A of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010 (as amended) at Freedom Farm, Cowles Drove, Hockwold, Thetford, IP26 4JQ.

The process detailed in the application is considered to be a 'Small Waste Incineration Plant' under the legislation but it should be noted that the pyrolysis of plastic is a thermal treatment to convert the plastic into liquid oil.
