

Hunstanton Heritage Gardens update



The £1.3m project to refurbish and repair the areas of the Greens, Esplanade Gardens and structures along the cliff top is now well underway. The project is supported by the National Lottery through the Heritage Lottery Fund and Big Lottery Fund and will be complete by mid-June 2017. With work started on the new play area and crazy golf, the Victorian shelters on cliff parade, the town sign and shelters situated around the Greens.
