The Council hereby grant permission for erection of 2 pairs of semi-detached houses and garages on site of Bull Row Cottages, Bull Bridge, Upwell in accordance with your application dated 12 April 1989 and the plans, drawings and documents which form part of the application, subject to standard condition A set out overleaf and to the additional conditions set out below.

CONDITIONS

- 1. An adequate space shall be provided within the site to enable vehicles to:
 - (a) enter and leave in forward gear;
 - (b) park clear of the public highway.

Reason - In the interests of highway safety.

- 2. The permanent space to be reserved on the site for:
 - (a) turning;
 - (b) parking;

shall be provided before the use commences and thereafter used for no other purpose.
