The Council hereby grant permission for the erection of 40 houses including installation of sewage treatment plant off Isle Bridge Road, Outwell in accordance with your application dated 5 July 1988 and the plans, drawings and documents which form part of the application, subject to standard condition A set out overleaf and to the additional conditions set out below.

CONDITIONS

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 (or any Order revoking and re-enacting that Order) planning permission shall be required in respect of fences, gates or walls erected within the curtilage of any dwelling in front of the forwardmost part of that dwelling fronting a highway.

Reason - To ensure that the appearance of the development is satisfactory and that it contributes to the visual character and amenity of the area.

2. The open space shall be graded and seeded or turfed to the satisfaction of the Local Planning Authority in the first planting/seeding season following occupation of any part of the development or completion of the development whichever is the sooner, and that area shall not thereafter be used for any purpose other than as a play area/communal open space.
