The Council hereby refuse permission for extension to outbuilding to provide extra accommodation for second set of elderly relatives at Post Office, Town Street, Upwell in accordance with your Application dated 6th March 1986 for the following reasons:

- 1. It is not the policy of the District Planning Authority to encourage the provision of a second extension for elderly relatives in the absence of special justification and details showing evidence of need (e.g. doctor's letter).
- 2. The proposal perpetuates an existing and undesirable form of backland development which would result in unacceptable level of amenity and use of an unsuitable means of vehicular access and would create difficulties for collecting and delivery services.
