

The Council hereby refuse permission for alterations to form a detached bungalow at old telephone exchange, Town Street, Upwell in accordance with your Application dated 8th January 1985 for the following reason:

"The proposed development constitutes piecemeal development on backland and would be out of character with this part of the village. The conversion to a dwelling would interfere with the reasonable amenities of the adjoining residential occupiers."
