Any trees removed with the consent of the Local Planning Authority, or any trees planted in accordance with a landscape scheme and which are dying, dead, or being seriously damaged or becoming seriously diseased or dangerous are removed without such consent shall be replaced with trees of such size and species as may be agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority.

Reason - To safeguard the character of the area and to assimilate the development into its surroundings.
