REFUSAL OF PLANNING PERMISSION

The Council hereby refuse permission for alterations and extension to dwelling:

at Cottage, Town Street, Upwell

in accordance with your Application dated 12th March, 1976

for the following reasons:

1. In the opinion of the Local Planning Authority the proposed alterations do not have adequate regard to the traditional character of the area reflected in adjoining dwellings and amends the style of the existing building to an unacceptable degree.
2. The proposed alterations in fenestration are totally unsympathetic to the existing dwelling and its semi-detached neighbour and would create a totally incongruous element in the street scene in an important position in the village centre.
