ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

- 1. No development shall be started until full details of the following have been submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority:-
 - (a) the siting, design and external appearance of the buildings and the means of access thereto;
 - (b) plans and elevations of all buildings and other structures;
 - (c) colour and type of facing materials to be used for external walls and roofs;
 - (d) the provision to be made on the site for the parking of 2 cars.
- 2. The detailed plans required under condition one shall provide for a dwelling with a steeply pitched roof so that due regard may be paid to the appearance and character of surrounding development.
- 3. The existing buildings on the site shall be demolished to the satisfaction of the Local Planning Authority within six months of the dwelling hereby permitted being occupied.
- 4. The vehicular access to the mite shall be mituated to pair with the existing access of the adjoining land to the west.
