The Council as local planning authority hereby grant permission for erection of dormitory with all requirements, including car park and drive (in connection with equestrian centre)

including

at Rectory Road, Outwell in the Rural District of Wisbech, Ordnance Survey Sheet, Cambridgeshire (Isle of Ely) XIII:1, part parcels 17 and 15, (1903 Edition), scale 1/2500th,

in accordance with your application dated 18th September, 1973 and more particularly shown on the drawing(s) attached hereto, and subject to the following conditions:

1. The development to which this permission relates must be begun not later than the expiration of two years beginning with the date of this decision notice.
2. The dormitory shall be occupied only in connection with the equestrian centre and for no other purpose.

Reasons for conditions:

1. To ensure that consideration of any future application for development in the area will not be prejudiced by permissions for development which have not been acted upon.
2. The Local Planning Authority would not be prepared to consider the use of the site for any other purpose other than an equestrian centre.

This permission is granted subject to due compliance with the bye-laws and general statutory provisions in force in the district and does NOT constitute approval under bye-laws relating to new streets and buildings.
