# Refusal of planning permission

TO : Mr. R. R. Clow, Gills Road, Outwell, Wisbech. per: Messrs. Mossop & Bowser, 13 South Brink, Wisbech.

The Council as local planning authority hereby refuse permission for residential development

at Back Lane, Outwell in the Hural District of Wisbech, Ordnance Survey Sheet, Cambridgeshire (Isle of Ely) VIII:13, part parcel 22, (1927 Edition), scale 1/2500th, as shown on the attached plan, reference WR/72/100/0

in accordance with your Application dated 23th Appl1, 1972

#### for the following reasons:

- 1. The site is indicated as 'white' land on the approved County Development Plan within which it is intended that the existing uses shall remain for the most part undisturbed.
- 2. The site is outside the Village Development Area for Sutwell and the area shown for residential development on the New Droft Village Plan for Outwell.
- 3. In the opinion of the Local Flanning Authority ample land is available for residential development which is included in the new Village Plan and which should be developed in the first instance.
- 4. The proposal represents an undesirable extension to the existing sporadic form of ribbon development on the outskirts of the village.
- 5. The proposal would be likely to give rise to additional highway hazards by reason of slowing, turning and waiting traffic in the vicinity of the site.
- 6. It is considered that this proposal would be out of character with the rural appearance of the area and would be detrimental to the amenities of the surrounding area.
