in accordance with your application dated 1st June 1972 and more particularly shown on the drawing(s) attached hereto, and subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The development to which this permission relates must be begun not later than the expiration of five years beginning with the date of this decision notice.
- 2. Provision shall be made on the site to enable vehicles using the site to enter and leave in forward gear.
- 3. Any access gates shall be set back to a position on the southeast side of the drain.
- 4. The existing access shall be the only access to be used.
- 5. Upon the substantial completion of the development live trees shall be planted in accordance with a scheme which shall be submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority and any trees which die shall be replaced.
- 6. Upon the substantial completion of the development the site shall be treated in accordance with a landscape scheme to be submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority and shall thereafter be satisfactorily maintained.
- Reasons for conditions:
  7. The occupation of the dwelling shall be limited to persons employed locally in agriculture as defined in Section 290 (i) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 or in forestry, and the dependent seef such persons.
- 8. A satisfactory scheme of external finishes shall be agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority prior to commencement of building works and the development shall be carried out in accordance with the agreed details.
