The Council as local planning authority hereby refuse permission for residential development

at The Cottons, Outwell in the Rural District of Wisbech, Ordnance Survey Sheet, Cambridgeshire (Isle of Rly) XIII:1, part parcel 98, (1903 Edition), scale 1/2500th, as shown on the attached plan, reference WR/72/219/0

in accordance with your Application dated 29th August, 1972

for the following reasons:

- 1. The site is indicated as 'white' land on the approved County Development Plan within which it is intended that the existing uses shall remain for the most part undisturbed.
- 2. The site of this proposal is not shown in the Draft Village Plan for Outwell as being zoned for residential purposes.
- 3. The proposal would in the opinion of the Local Planning Authority constitute an undesirable group of isolated development outside the main part of the village of Outwell.
- 4. In the opinion of the Local Planning Authority the development of this peripheral site, for residential purposes, would progressively detract from the reasonable amenities and character of the surrounding area.
- 5. If approved the proposal would be likely to lead to other applications of a similar nature which the Local Flanning Authority could not fairly resist.
