The Council as local planning authority hereby grant permission for retention of a temporary sales shop

including

at 3 Cottons Head, Outwell in the Rural District of Wisbech, Ordnance Survey Sheet, Cambridgeshire (Isle of Ely) XIII.1, part parcel 97, (1903 Edition), scale 1/2500th,

in accordance with your application dated 24th November, 1972 and more particularly shown on the drawing(s) attached hereto, and subject to the following conditions:

1. The building, the subject of this permission, shall be removed from the site on or before 31st January, 1974.
2. This permission shall ensure solely for the benefit of the applicant, Mr. N. Pope.
3. The building shall be maintained in a good condition to the satisfaction of the Local Planning Authority throughout the duration of the planning permission.

### Reasons for conditions:

1. The building by reason of its materials of construction and appearance is not suitable for permanent retention.
2. To ensure that planning control is retained by the Local Planning Authority on the disposal of the present applicants interest in the land or buildings.
3. In the interests of the appearance of the building within the surrounding area.

This permission is granted subject to due compliance with the bye-laws and general statutory provisions in force in the district and does NOT constitute approval under bye-laws relating to new streets and buildings.
