## SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS

The Council as local planning authority hereby grant permission for the retention of a temporary sales shop including

at 3 Cottons Head, Outwell in the Rural District of Wisbech, Ordnance Survey Sheet, Cambridgeshire (Isle of Ely) XIII:1, part parcel 97, (1903 Edition), scale 1/2500th,

in accordance with your application dated 22nd July, 1971 and more particularly shown on the drawing(s) attached hereto, and subject to the following conditions:

1. The building the subject of this permission shall be removed and the land reinstated to its former condition on or before 30th September, 1972.
2. The permission hereby given shall ensure for the benefit of and shall not be exercised by any person other than Mr. N. Pope.

## Reasons for conditions:

1. The building by reason of its materials of construction and appearance is not suitable for permanent retention.
2. To ensure that planning control is retained by the Local Planning Authority on the disposal of the present applicant's interest in the land or building.

This permission is granted subject to due compliance with the bye-laws and general statutory provisions in force in the district and does NOT constitute approval under bye-laws relating to new streets and buildings.
