The Council as local planning authority hereby refuse permission for the erection of an 'Arcon' prefabricated building for use as an agricultural implement store

at Lynwood House, Town Street, Upwell, in the Rural District of Wisbech, Ordnance Survey Sheet, Cambridgeshire (Isle of Ely) XIII : 1, part parcel 64, (1903 Edition), scale 1/2500th, as shown on the attached plan, reference WR/69/130/D

in accordance with your Application dated 1st August, 1969
for the following reasons:

1. In the opinion of the Local Planning Authority the erection of a building for the storage of farm implements in a predominantly residential area would be detrimental to the amenities of the dwellings in the vicinity of the site.
2. The design of the proposed building falls below a minimum acceptable standard having particular regard to its materials of construction and would be inappropriate on this attractive residential site.
