at Pius Drove, Upwell, in the Rural District of Wisbech, Ordnance Survey Sheet, Cambridgeshire (Isle of Ely) XIII : 1, part parcel 22 (1903 edition), scale 1/2500th, as shown on the attached plan reference WR/68/46/D,

in accordance with your Application dated 1st April, 1968,

and subject to the following conditions:

The turning spaces indicated on the attached plan shall be constructed concurrently with their related dwelling.

Reasons for conditions:

To enable vehicles to enter and leave the site in forward gear and in the interests of highway safety.

This permission is granted subject to due compliance with the bye-laws and general statutory provisions in force in the district and does NOT constitute approval under bye-laws relating to new streets and buildings.
