The Council as local planning authority hereby grant permission for the erection of a potato store

at Wisbech Road, Outwell, in the Rural District of Wisbech, Ordnance Survey Sheet, Cambridgeshire (Isle of Ely) XIII:1, part parcel No. 75, 1903 Edition, scale 1/2500th, as shown on the attached plan, reference No. WR/68/93/D

in accordance with your Application dated 7th May, 1968,

and subject to the following conditions:

1. The building shall be erected by or on behalf of Hannam & Davy Ltd.
2. Building operations shall be commenced within one year of the date of the planning permission.
3. None of the floor space of the building shall be used for the carrying on of processes for or incidental to the purposes specified in Section 21 of the Local Employment Act, 1960.
4. Upon the substantial completion of the development live trees shall be planted in accordance with a scheme which shall be submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority, and any trees which die shall be replaced.
5. See condition overleaf.

Reasons for conditions:

- 1, 2 & 3. These are conditions of the Board of Trade.
4. To help to assimilate the development into its surroundings.

This permission is granted subject to due compliance with the bye-laws and general statutory provisions in force in the district and does NOT constitute approval under bye-laws relating to new streets and buildings.
