

Reasons for conditions continued ...

2. In order to provide a satisfactory turning space within the site to comply with the conditions attached to the outline planning permission O.A.2397, and in order that motor vehicles may enter and leave the site in a forward gear.
3. In the interests of the appearance of the development and to assimilate the development more easily within the surrounding countryside and in order to comply with the condition attached to O.A.2397.
4. In the interests of the appearance of the development and in order to comply with the condition attached to the outline planning permission in respect of O.A.2397.
5. In the interests of highway safety.
6. In the interests of the appearance of the building.
