BCKLWN Local Plan Review - Consultation Draft Stage

Guidance Introduction

The Local Plan in the Borough currently consists of the Core Strategy (adopted in 2011) and the Site Allocations and Development Management Policies Plan (SADMP, adopted in 2016). These two documents have been reviewed and the new combined draft document sets out a strategy and detail for delivering growth in the Borough, identifying where development should be located and how it should be delivered up to 2036. The Review Plan sets out the policies which the Council will use to determine planning applications alongside those contained in made Neighbourhood Plans. It will also identify sites for housing, employment and other land uses through 'site allocations'.

The Local Plan Review combines the Core Strategy and the SADMP and updates it to a 2036 end date. Policies have been reassessed, suitable new sites proposed and offered for comment in this consultation.

The Local Plan Review Document is published in order for comments to be made prior to submission.

In such cases the group should indicate how many people it is representing and how the representation has been authorised.
