## WOLFERTON CREEK TO SOUTH HUNSTANTON

## NOVEMBER UPDATE 2019

From September 28th to October 2nd there were a series of high tides resulting in numerous flood warnings and flood alerts being issued for the areas of Snettisham Sea Front, Heacham Sea Front and Hunstanton.

The high tides resulted in there being some cliffing and damage to the shingle ridge at Heacham and Snettisham. Concerns have been raised by local residents that emergency repairs would need to be carried out before the normal annual recycling works which are completed in February/ March each year. The Environment Agency have assessed the damage and determined that there is no need for any urgent or emergency works at this time. Subject to no further damage over the winter period, normal recycling works will commence as usual in February/ March 2020.

The Environment Agency will continue to monitor the shingle ridge on a regular basis as normal and reassess if required.
