- 6. New applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy) at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Wednesday 21 July 2021**.
- 7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Kings Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by 5 pm on Thursday 29 July 2021. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday 21 July 2021. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday 21 July 2021.
