

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

Referendum on the adoption of the Terrington St John Neighbourhood Plan

1. The referendum will take place on **Thursday 30 September 2021** to decide on the question below:

‘Do you want the Borough Council of King’s Lynn and West Norfolk to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Terrington St John to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?’

2. The last date for registering to vote in respect of the Neighbourhood Planning Referendum is **Tuesday 14 September 2021**.
3. New postal vote (including proxies applying to vote by post) applications, changes or cancellations to existing postal, postal proxy or proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King’s Court, Chapel Street, King’s Lynn PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Wednesday 15 September 2021**.
4. New applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy) at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King’s Court, Chapel Street, King’s Lynn PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Wednesday 22 September 2021**.
5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King’s Court, Chapel Street, King’s Lynn PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Thursday 30 September 2021**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after **5 pm on Wednesday 22 September 2021**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after **5 pm on Wednesday 22 September 2021**.
