



Castle Acre Neighbourhood Development Plan

Adoption Statement

**Town & Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) Section 31E (4)(b)
Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, Regulations 19 & 20**

BACKGROUND

Castle Acre Parish Council has prepared a Neighbourhood Development Plan. This has successfully passed its independent examination and a local referendum, and is now being brought into force by the Borough Council (as the local planning authority for the area). The Castle Acre Neighbourhood Plan will now form part of the development plan for the whole of the Parish of Castle Acre and be used to help guide development and make decisions on planning applications in Castle Acre Parish.

DECISION

The Borough Council decided on **10th February 2022** to 'make' (adopt or bring into legal force) the Castle Acre Neighbourhood Development Plan, as approved at referendum, with effect from **10th February 2022**.

REASON

The amended (referendum version) Castle Acre Neighbourhood Development Plan meets the Basic Conditions and other legal requirements and was supported by a majority of votes in a local referendum held on 27th January 2022.
