Public Sector Apprenticeship Target

Period 1st April 2021 – 31st March 2022

Public sector bodies with 250 or more staff in England had a target to employ an average of at least 2.3% (between 1st April 2017 to 31st March 2021) of their staff as new apprentice starts.

Although the council is no long required to publish this target we have decided to continue the practice as part of our commitment to transparency. The submission for the period 1st April 2021 to 31st March 2022 has been uploaded to the National Apprentice Service Portal.

This document provides a summary of the information submitted at the Data Publication Section of the return and has been compiled in line with the requirements of the Digital Apprentice Service.
