**Re: Request to have the village of Syderstone designated as a Neighbourhood Area**

Syderstone Parish Council hereby requests permission for the Parish of Syderstone to be designated a Neighbourhood Area in accordance with Regulation 5 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, as amended.

It is requested that the Syderstone Parish boundary is designated the boundary for the Syderstone Neighbourhood Area. A map of the Parish boundary is contained in Annex 1.

Syderstone Parish Council believe the Parish boundary to be appropriate to be designated as a Neighbourhood Area for the following reasons:

- It comprises the whole geographical area of the Parish of Syderstone
- It is the local government administrative area for the Parish of Syderstone
- It enables proper and effective neighbourhood planning to include the whole area of Syderstone Parish Council
- It supports the provisions of Section 61G (4a) of Town and Country Planning Act 1990, as amended by The Localism Act 2011, "in determining the application, the authority must have regard to- (a) the desirability of designating the whole of the area of a parish council as a neighbourhood area

Statement of qualifying body: Syderstone Parish Council is a relevant body permitted to make this area application for the purposes of section 61G of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).
