West Norfolk Rural Community Capital Grants

Funding is available over two years for community organisations in the rural areas of the Borough of King's Lynn and West Norfolk.

Projects should provide resilient community services and assets for local people to benefit the local economy, address the challenges of rural isolation, support social cohesion and boost local pride.

Applications are open for year 1 from 12th June to 2nd August 2023.

Year 2

2024-25 | Grants of up to £50,000

Aim: Capacity building and infrastructure support for local civil society and community groups through larger scale capital improvement projects, such as climate resilient infrastructure which can adapt to changing external factors, net zero infrastructure, grants for community catering kitchens, etc.
