In addition to the Book of Remembrance that is located at Mintlyn Crematorium, you can select to have a Personal Book or Remembrance Card.





These are personal editions of the inscription. The Personal Book has your chosen inscription as well as extra pages to allow additional inscriptions or memorial entries should you wish. Whilst the Remembrance Card will display your chosen inscription in a folded card.


It is not necessary to have an entry in the Book of Remembrance to select to have the Personal Book or Remembrance Card. You can select just to buy these more personal memorials.

To assist you with your entry we can provide some examples of frequently used wording and emblems.

The Book of Remembrance is a permanent memorial.

The book is accessible to view for 'today's date' every day of the year in a display case in a dedicated room at Mintlyn Crematorium.

Should you wish to view a different date other than 'today' we would ask that you make an appointment. If the book is away at our supplier, the entry can be viewed via a computer at the crematorium.

Each book is for a specific period that is January to March, April to June, July to September, October to December. Other than when the book for the next quarter is at our supplier having new inscriptions added, all books are at Mintlyn.

Entry into the Book of Remembrance is not automatic.

You can select to have an inscription from a simple 2 line memorial, up to as many lines as you wish. For inscriptions of 5 lines or more you can select to have an additional emblem with the inscription. We do limit the number of letters/ spaces to 40 per line or 35 if there is to be an emblem.

The choice of wording on the inscription, other than the first line which will be the surname and first names of the deceased, is entirely your choice.

We do reserve the right to amend or refuse any entry we feel may cause offence to others.

The date of entry is your choice. Many select the anniversary for date of death, but it can be the date of birth, anniversary or other special date. However, we will only permit entries on 11 November, 25 December, 1 January and 14 February where it is the anniversary for date of death.

The choice of any emblem is also yours, for example cats, dogs, birds, military cap badges or similar, flowers, trees and bunches of flowers. If you are unsure then please feel free to discuss your choice with our office staff.

As the book for each quarter is sent away in advance, we must ask that if you wish an inscription to be in the Book of Remembrance for the anniversary that you apply for this at least 6 months in advance of that date to ensure it is included.
