

Old Hunstanton Neighbourhood Plan 2021-2036 Adoption Statement

Town & Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) Section 31E (4)(b) Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, Regulations 19 & 20

BACKGROUND

The Old Hunstanton Parish Council has prepared a Neighbourhood Development Plan ("Neighbourhood Plan"), covering that Parish area. This has successfully passed its independent examination and a local referendum and is now being brought into force by the Borough Council (as the local planning authority for the area). The Old Hunstanton Neighbourhood Plan 2021-2036 will now form part of the development plan for the whole of the Parish of Old Hunstanton and be used to help guide development and make decisions on planning applications in Old Hunstanton Parish.

DECISION

The Borough Council decided on 15th February 2024 to 'make' (adopt or bring into legal force) the Old Hunstanton Neighbourhood Plan 2021-2036, as approved at referendum, with effect from 8th February 2024.

REASON

The amended (referendum version) Old Hunstanton Neighbourhood Plan meets the Basic Conditions and other legal requirements and was supported by a majority of votes in a local referendum held on 8th February 2024.
