

KING'S LYNN & WEST NORFOLK LOCAL PLAN REVIEW EXAMINATION

West Winch Growth Area – Historic England Statement of Common Ground – Outstanding issues from Day 8 (28 March 2024)

On Day 8 (28 March 2024), during the discussion around heritage assets in/ around the West Winch Growth Area (WWGA), the Inspectors highlighted the following matters that would need to be resolved/ agreed between Historic England and the Borough Council:

- Further changes to Policy E2.1 to include the further changes suggested by Historic England in their Hearing Statement; and
- Establish the potential for specifying a buffer zone around and key views of the heritage assets, in particular St Mary's Church and the group including the moated site

The Inspectors requested that these issues be resolved by way of a Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) between the main parties. The SoCG was prepared as an update to the previous version [F28], dated 30 November 2022. The SoCG update is submitted as an addendum to this note.
