The statement in the table

The largest strategic allocation for King's Lynn and West Norfolk for 4,000 homes in the fulness of time is allocated by the Local Plan here. This includes land within North Runcton and West Winch Parish. Given this and that parts of the Growth Area are what could be considered to be part of the existing built-up area of West Winch, a figure of **95 dwellings** would be appropriate (25% reduction).

How does having an allocation of 4000 houses in a neighbourhood area make a reduction of 25% to 95 appropriate?? How is this figure arrived at?
