

Nominations (1 of 2)

- Nomination Packs / Guidance: Electoral Commission website
- www.west-norfolk.gov.uk/GeneralElection
- 10 subscribers required (within the same constituency)
- Check elector numbers against the Electoral Register
- Qualifications to stand as an MP (Candidates' Responsibility)
- Candidate Description: Registered Political Party Description / Independent / Blank
- Include ALL pages (even if blank)
- £500 Deposit (paid by 4pm on 7 June 2024)



Nominations (2 of 2)

- Informal checks (by e-mail)
- Formal delivery of Nomination Papers (4-7 June between 10am- 4pm)
- Must be delivered by hand:
 - Please make an appointment where possible
 - By: Candidate, Election Agent or Proposer/Seconder
 - o Tel: 01553 616773 or E-mail: elections@west-norfolk.gov.uk
 - Main Reception of BCKLWN Offices @ King's Court
 - Early submission is recommended in case of errors
 - Open to inspection



Candidate Literature / Guidance

- NOT the responsibility of the (Acting) Returning Officer or Elections staff to check qualification information or offer guidance
- Ultimate responsibility lies with Agent / Candidate
- Imprints on ALL printed campaign materials (including electronic)
- Please read Electoral Commission Guidance
- Any issues will be referred to the Police 'SPOC' (Electoral offences)



Campaigning

"Campaigners are an essential element of a healthy democracy, and their right to put their arguments to voters should be supported and protected. It is equally important, however, to ensure that the activities of campaigners do not bring into question the integrity of the electoral process."

Registration

- Candidates uniquely placed to encourage people to register to vote
- Deadline to apply for these elections: Tuesday 18 June
- No need to re-register if already registered
- www.gov.uk/registertovote (easiest and fastest method)
- Encouraging people to have a postal vote?
 - Explain they must be registered first
 - Apply in time (5pm Wednesday 19 June)



Voter-ID (What we are doing locally)

- Advert on Bin Calendar (sent to every household in the Borough)
- Two phases (emphasis on applying followed by "please remember")
- Lynn News & Your Local Paper
- Social Media
- Parish publications
- Bus Shelters / Car Parking Machines / Litter Bins
- Electronic Car Park Displays
- Cinema Adverts



Polling Stations

- 68 Polling Stations (North West Norfolk)
- 75 Polling Stations (South West Norfolk)
 - 37 in King's Lynn & West Norfolk
 - **38** in Breckland
- Situation of Polling Stations is published by 5pm Friday 7 June
- Polling Station Inspectors



Voter Authority Certificate (VAC)

- Individuals who do not have or wish to use one of the accepted forms of Photo-ID can apply for a Voter Authority Certificate (VAC)
- Online or Paper application form

Postal Vote – Opening Sessions

 - Please provide notification of attendance beforehand
 - At least 24 hours notice will be given for any changes to arrangements/cancellations.
 - Sessions are dependent on quantities of votes received



Verification / The Count

- Alive Lynnsport Leisure Centre
- Admittance from 9.30pm
- Enter through main entrance (via reception)
- Verification will begin Thursday 4 July @ approx. 10.30pm
- Some SWN Ballot Boxes will be arriving from Breckland
- Each constituency: 7 tables / 6 counting assistants each (42 in total)
- Security on the entrance doors and inside the main hall
- Potential large media presence
- Declaration of Results made by High Sheriff



General Election 2024 – Count Layout




Verification / The Count

- Only 'appointed' persons may attend
 - Election Staff
 - Media
 - Candidates + Candidate Guest x 1
 - Election Agent
 - Sub-Agent (if appointed)
 - Counting Agents
- Number of Counting Agents (TBC after close of nominations)
 - Based upon Electoral Commission Formula
- You must remain in your appointed constituency
 - Unless appointed in both constituencies
- Lanyards will be provided must be worn throughout
 - Different Lanyards for different roles/areas
 - Collect your lanyard upon first arrival at the door of sports hall











Candidate Expenses

- Deadline: Friday 9 August
- Submit to the (Acting) Returning Officer
- Must submit even if NIL expenses were incurred
- Remember Agent & Candidate's Declaration
- Available for inspection
- Responsibility of Election Agent (or Candidate)
- Check Electoral Commission Guidance



Candidate Expenses

- Fixed amount of £11,390 + 12p per Registered Elector
- Eligible electorate figure on <u>3 June 2024</u> (Notice of Election)

- North West Norfolk (73,674) = £8,840.88 £20,230.88
- South West Norfolk (73,770) = £8,852.40 £20,242.40
