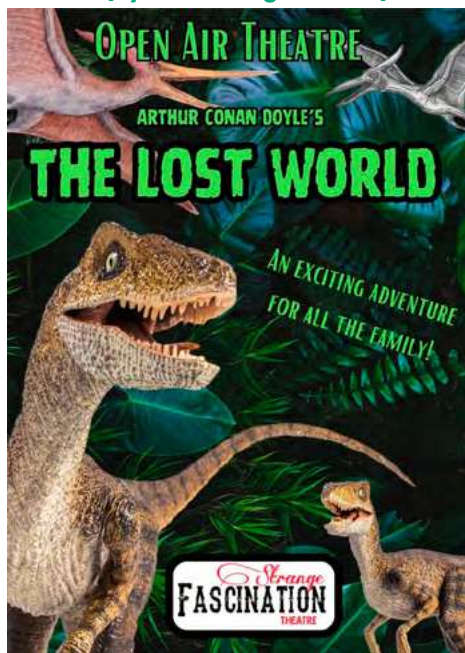

LEARN TO SWIM SAFELY

Swim Safe is fun and free water safety activity for children created by swim England and the RNLI that takes place on the sea front in partnership with Alive Oasis and the BCKLWN.

Swim Safe is open to children aged 7-14. To take part, they must be able to swim a minimum of 25m. (This is usually achieved around Stage 6 of Swim England's Learn to Swim Pathway). A parent/ guardian must be present throughout the session.

Putting and Crazy Golf

In the Heritage Gardens, at the top of the North Promenade. Brush up on your putting skills at our 18-hole putting green or have some fun on the 12-hole crazy golf course!

Putting: Adult £4.40; **Junior** £3.60

Crazy Golf: Adult £3.70; **Junior** £3.20

Open daily from 1 April – 30 September, and October Half Term. Closed November to March. Turn up and play from 9am. Closure time is weather (and how busy the resort is) dependent.

Pitch & Putt and Footgolf

Our nine-hole courses are side by side on the Cliff Top with excellent views across the Wash. Budding golfers will find pitch & putt good practice for approach shots and putting but it's also a fun family activity too. Footgolf fuses football with golf with the aim of getting a football into the hole in as few shots as possible; great fun and suitable for any age. No particular equipment required but **studded boots or shoes are not permitted on the course.**
