Air Quality Revocation Order 2025

The Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk (the "**Council**") makes the following Order under Section 83(2)(b) Environment Act 1995.

WHEREAS

- A. On 1st April 2009, pursuant to section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995, the Council made an Air Quality Management Order for an area within the Gaywood Clock ward (the "**2009 Order**"). That area (shown hatched in red on the map attached to the 2009 Order, the **Gaywood Air Quality Management Area**) was designated in respect of likely breaches of standards and objectives for Nitrogen Dioxide (NO₂).
- B. The Council has annually reviewed NO₂ levels within the designated area against air quality standards and objectives.
- C. In each of 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024, air quality standards for NO₂ have been achieved.
- D. The Council is therefore satisfied that the relevant air quality standards and objectives are being achieved and are likely to continue to be achieved.
- E. On 17 September 2024, Cabinet resolved to revoke the designation of the Gaywood Air Quality Management Area.

THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- 1. The 2009 Order is revoked in its entirety with immediate effect.
- 2. The area subject to the 2009 Order shall cease to be designated as an Air Quality Management Area with immediate effect.
- 3. The Order shall be cited as the Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk Air Quality Management Order Revocation Order 2025.
- 4. This Order shall come into force on 04 February 2025.
