
WATER ON SITE

Thankfully the water is now non-existent. We were able to pump away any ground water at the approved rate and in accordance with our permit to discharge as we were installing the vast water holding tanks. We have also been lucky as this last winter was much drier than the previous one.

The first section of tank is now complete and covered over: we're sure you would agree that you would never know it was there.



We have previously mentioned that the attenuation tanks can hold over 3,660 cubic meters of water, being equivalent to nearly six times the volume that St James swimming pool holds. They are designed to help the estate cope with a 1 in 100-year flooding event. Below is an extract showing the scale of the tanks. The smaller tank to the right below is an overflow tank which is due to progress within the next couple of months.



COMPLETED WORKS AND WHAT'S COMING UP

We have completed several plots on Phase 1, with our first customers having moved into their new homes on Florence Fields. We would like to welcome our new residents: we hope you love living in your new Lovell home and enjoy experiencing what the local area has to offer.

We have been progressing well with construction of Phase 2, having completed several of the first houses on this phase.

We have also made a good start on the next phase of homes, with a number of these already progressing to first floor height. Phase 3 includes the first blocks of flats with several shared ownership and private rental plots.





Work on the play park is due to begin soon and we hope to be in a position to report on progress in the next newsletter, in September.

We'll be replacing some existing items that have come to the end of their lifespan as well as putting in some new pieces of equipment.




SCHEME BENEFITS

As part of offsite enhancements connected to this scheme, we will be planting 51 trees. This represents the planting of three trees for every one we had to remove on the site. The position of the new sites relative to Florence Fields and the plans for the area are shown on the plans below.



The sites include a new formal avenue of lime trees on one of the green spaces near Fairstead (Site 1) and a scattered planting of native black poplar on the edge of a new nature reserve to be formed on land to the west of Queen Elizabeth Way (Site 2).

INTERESTING FACT

Did you know that the reason the scheme is called Florence Fields is due to a competition held back in 2023 for the students at KLA to come up with an inspirational name and logo.

The students came up with the name in honour of a lady named Florence Green, who lived nearby until February 2012, when she died at the age of 110.



Mrs Green was part of the Women's Royal Air Force, which she joined at the age of 17 in September 1918. She worked as a steward in the mess at RAF Narborough and was believed to have been the longest surviving person to have served in uniform during the First World War before she passed away.

DANGERS OF BUILDING SITES

We know building sites hold great interest for some people, especially youngsters, and we would ask you to remind children of the dangers of building sites, in particular young children and teenagers.

Please be particularly aware of the lorries delivering to and leaving the site. Please make sure you are seen, and we can see you!

Lovell Partnerships take care to ensure the site perimeter is safe and secure and the site is fully locked up at the end of each day. Our gateperson works tirelessly to ensure public safety at the site entrance and cleans all vehicles leaving site.

MINIMISING DISRUPTION

We would like to thank you for your patience regarding construction vehicle movement into and out of site, particularly with the size of some of our deliveries.

We appreciate that construction projects have an impact on our neighbours and surrounding residents.

The designated site working hours are:

7:30am - 5:00pm Monday to Friday, with occasional Saturday mornings (if necessary). Deliveries are between 8:00am and 4:00pm.

MINIMISING LANDFILL

As a partnership that cares about the impact of construction on the environment, we are always striving to eliminate the waste we create during the construction process. This in turn reduces the amount of waste that goes to landfill. Typically, Lovell will use this approach:

REDUCE: can we prevent and reduce waste generation in the first place? REUSE: can we give the products a second life before they become waste? RECYCLE: can waste materials be re-processed into products, materials, or substances whether for the original or other purposes?

RECOVERY: if we can't reuse or recycle, can we incinerate to produce alternative energy?

DISPOSAL: as a last resort, some waste is sent to landfill. Currently only 0.28% of Lovell waste goes to landfill. 99.72% gets reused/recycled etc.

CONSIDERATE CONSTRUCTORS SCHEME



The site has been registered with the Considerate Constructors Scheme (CCS), which means that how we interact with our neighbours and operate our site will be assessed by an independent body. More information on CCS can be found at <u>www.ccscheme.org.uk</u>.

CCS is an independent scheme that monitors our construction site against a code of considerate practice, designed to encourage best practice beyond statutory requirements.

There are three main areas monitored:

- Respect the Community Constructors should give utmost consideration to their impact on neighbours and the public
- Care for the Environment Constructors should protect and enhance the environment
- Value their Workforce Constructors should provide a supportive and caring working environment
