

The Walpoles Neighbourhood Plan 2022-2036 Adoption Statement

Town & Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) Section 31E (4)(b) Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, Regulations 19 & 20

BACKGROUND

The Walpoles Parish Council has prepared a Neighbourhood Development Plan ("Neighbourhood Plan") covering three settlements: Walpole St Peter, Walpole St Andrew and Walpole Marsh. The Plan has successfully passed independent examination and a local referendum. It is now being brought into force by the Borough Council, acting as the Local Planning Authority for the area. The Walpoles Neighbourhood Plan 2022 - 2036 will now form part of the development plan for the entire Parish of The Walpoles and will be used to help guide development and make decisions on planning applications in The Walpoles Parish.

DECISION

The Borough Council decided on **1 December 2025** to 'make' (adopt or bring into legal force) The Walpoles Neighbourhood Plan 2022-2036, as approved at referendum, with effect from **1 December 2025**.

REASON

The amended (referendum version) The Walpoles Neighbourhood Plan meets the Basic Conditions and other legal requirements and was supported by a majority of votes in a local referendum held on **13 November 2025.**
