



## **Community Governance Review – Unparished area of King's Lynn**

### **NOTICE OF REVIEW**

In accordance with the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007, the Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk is undertaking a Community Governance Review of the unparished area of King's Lynn.

Following a meeting at 'Full Council', the Borough Council has agreed to conduct a Community Governance Review to establish whether or not there is a desire from residents for the emparishment of all or part of the current unparished area of King's Lynn into one or more civil parishes.

The Borough Council is conducting an initial consultation for the review process and is inviting residents and any other party or body which appears to the Borough Council to have an interest in the review to submit their views.
