Nomination papers must be delivered to the Deputy Returning Officer, King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX on any day after the date of this notice, during normal office hours but no later than **4 pm on Thursday 9 April 2026**. Where possible, can candidates please make an appointment with the Deputy Returning Officer in order that their nomination can be handed in by this deadline. Any request for an appointment should be made via email at: elections@west-norfolk.gov.uk or telephone **01553 616773**.
3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 7 May 2026**.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by **midnight on Monday 20 April 2026**. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register tovot e
5. New postal vote applications (including proxies applying to vote by post), changes or cancellations to existing postal, postal proxy or proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Tuesday 21 April 2026**.

6. New applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy) at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026**.
7. Applications for Voter Authority Certificates must be made by **5 pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026**.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Kings Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Thursday 7 May 2026**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after **5 pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after **5 pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026**.
