

MIDDLETON PARISH COUNCIL REGISTER OF MEMBERS' DISCLOSABLE PECUNIARY INTERESTS

The relevant Authority's (Disclosable Pecuniary Interests) Regulations 2012

Members are required to register the following disclosable pecuniary interests. Members have a disclosable pecuniary interest if it is of a description specified in Parts 1 - 3 below and it is the Member's interest or it is an interest of the following 'relevant person':

- (a) the Member's spouse or civil partner;
 - (b) a person with whom the Member is living as husband and wife, or
 - (c) a person with whom the Member is living as if they were civil partners,
- and the Member is aware that the other person has the interest.

Members should give a description of the nature of the disclosable pecuniary interest in Part 1 above, whether it is the interest or an interest of a 'relevant person' described in Parts 2 or 3, giving the name of the other person and the nature of their relationship with the Member. Guidance notes are attached to assist Members in completing this form.

Appendix B

- (ii) any body—
 - (a) exercising functions of a public nature;
 - (b) directed to charitable purposes; or
 - (c) one of whose principal purposes includes the influence of public opinion or policy (including any political party or trade union) of which the member of the Council is a member or in a position of general control or management;
- (iii) any gifts or hospitality worth more than an estimated value of £50 which the member has received by virtue of his or her office.
